### **WHAT TO WEAR**

According to the weather forecast, the daytime temperatures will be 7–9 degrees. However, bear in mind that there is significant variation in the weather conditions, so it is a good idea to check the forecast closer to the seminar. At the time of writing this (May 1st), there is still a fair amount of snow on the ground in Inari, and although the ground might be bare at the end of May, it will likely still be quite wet. We recommend to dress in layers to accommodate for both the more active parts of the hikes as well as for the stationary moments, e.g. during lunch. A suggestion of items to bring for the Saturday Midnight Sun Hike & Sunday Nature Outing and Lunch in Open Air: shoes with good grip and some moisture resistance, warm woollen socks, thermal underwear, warm hiking or outside trousers, woollen or fleece sweater, insulated or wind proof jacket, gloves and hat.
